Conditions of Entry and dates to remember for the Harcourt's Youth Award

1. Theme: "Man, Myth or Magic" – your work is to represent this theme
2. Artwork must be 2D; up to A3 size and ready to hang with sufficient hooks etc.
3. Entry is open to senior students, under 18 years in the Coromandel Peninsula, Waikato & Western BOP.
4. Only One entry per person
5. Overall maximum of 25 entries for this award.
6. The selection of the artwork to be exhibited is the decision of the Whangamata Arts Collective Executive Committee and no further discussion regarding the selection will be entered into.
7. No entry fee
8. All work must be the original, sole work of the artist and have been completed in the last 12 months.
9. All artwork must be professionally presented and clearly identified – See tag example overleaf.
10. Art works may be for sale and must stay for the duration of the exhibition.
11. Entry forms must be submitted by **December 7**. Please email entry form to: jane@whangamata.school.nz
12. **Artworks must be delivered** to Jane Kay at Whangamata High School by Dec 7 (before school holidays start).
13. **Artworks will be collected after the event at 4 pm on Saturday, January 6th by Jane Kay.**
14. All risk, insurance and courier costs are the responsibility of the artist. ACW takes all care but no responsibility for your artwork.
